As you will see we have put together a "normal" schedule for this summer, and we hope you are as excited as our ELC staff to get back together hiking in the woods and paddling on the rivers. I wanted to let you know our expectations for this summer and how we plan to keep our students and staff safe while on these amazing adventures.

Programs will continue to have a more local focus- we will be asking parents to drop off and pick up their student. Please try your best to be on time and maybe even consider putting staff cell numbers in your phone in case we need to call you.

We will continue to do our absolute best to maintain 6 feet of physical distancing. When closer than 6 feet we will expect masks to be worn.

We continue to follow CDC and MDH guidelines and procedures, which includes wearing masks and sanitizing hands.

For extended programs or programs where we feel that maintaining distance and wearing a mask are not feasible- we will ask that students show a negative COVID test or proof of vaccination. Students who get into these programs will be sent more information about when and where these COVID test can be secured.

BIKING I: GRAVEL AND SINGLE TRACK

Minimum Age: 7th grade

Prerequisite for 7th grader: Explore Bike Touring

8th grade and above: no prerequisite
