CORE PROGRAMS

MOUNTAIN BIKING I

Minimum Age: 7th grade

Prerequisite for 7th grader: Explore Bike Touring

8th grade and above: no prerequisite

Fee: \$60.00

This program will explore the best of what Red Wing has to offer for mountain biking as well as exploring some new trails in the surrounding area. We will focus the first day on local trails and backroads. The second two days will be biking with an overnight.

Students will need their own mountain bike and helmet.

CANOEING I

Prerequisite: Explore Canoeing 8th grade and above: no prerequisite

It's time to pack the canoe for an overnight excursion along the Red Cedar and Chippewa River in Wisconsin. Prior to the overnight, you will spend time improving your steering skills, learning how to waterproof your gear for the boat, and searching for wildlife on the Vermillion and Mississippi rivers.
